

One access login, various systems – Brose Extranet enables our suppliers to access different Brose internal applications by using just one log in.

While working with many different applications in the Brose Extranet, we take the protection of personal information very seriously and pay close attention to this aspect with regard to our online activities.

Our privacy policy complies with the applicable data protection legislation, in particular Germany's Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz, BDSG) and Telemedia Act (Telemediengesetz, TMG).

### **1. What is covered by data protection?**

The aim of data protection is to protect the fundamental rights of every natural person as defined in Art. 1 of the DSGVO.

Data protection covers personal data. As defined in Art. 4 phrase 1 of the DSGVO, personal data means any information concerning the personal or material circumstances of an identified or identifiable natural person. This includes e.g. your name, postal address, email address or telephone number, but may also cover usage data like your IP address.

### **2. Processing of personal data**

Personal data from contact persons of our suppliers will be processed in the Brose Extranet and all connected applications. This data only includes master data (e.g. business address, e-mail address, telephone number).

This data will be processed for the management / execution of our delivery processes and connected processes (e.g. for sending orders by e-mail, requests to the supplier). The processing is based on corresponding contracts concluded with our suppliers.

The data will not be transmitted to companies outside the Brose Group.

Personal data will be deleted from the Brose Extranet as soon as we are informed that your responsibility for the above processes has expired.

### **3. Automatically collected data / usage data**

We store so-called usage data (IP address, access time, accessed website, used browser) in log files of our servers. This data is exclusively evaluated for the improvement of our offered services and does not allow any conclusion about your person.

### **4. Data security**

We secure our Brose Extranet with up-to-date technical and organizational measures to prevent your data being lost, destroyed, accessed, modified or disseminated by unauthorized persons. When sending personal data, we make use of encryption technology to ensure extremely high levels of confidentiality. Our servers use various security mechanisms and permission processes to make unauthorized access difficult. You should keep your access information secret at all times and close your browser window once you have finished communicating with Brose. This will ensure that no one apart from you can access your personal data if you share your computer with other people.

## **5. Right of access to information and right to revoke consent**

You have the right to receive information about your stored personal data free of charge on request. You also have the right to correct incorrect information, and to block or delete your personal data, provided there are no legal obligations to retain data that prevent this.
